Verification Tip: Packaging Materials and Printing Inks

Criterion 4.8.1.1, which applies to all three standards, addresses all packaging components, which includes any inks used to print on the packaging materials. During a Verification Round, Participating Manufacturers should be prepared to provide evidence supporting any inks used on a product's packaging materials.

Some examples of sufficient evidence include supplier letters as per the verification requirements, or other information such as analytical test reports.
