Correction to Eligibility Dates for Slates

The May 19 Manufacturer update indicated that ENERGY STAR version 6.1 would go into effect "in early June 2014, simultaneous with release of the 6.0 specification." That date was inaccurate.

Per an ENERGY STAR correction: "ENERGY STAR will release a final and effective Computers Version 6.1 specification in late summer 2014. The 6.1 specification will explicitly add three new categories of computing devices to the scope of the existing ENERGY STAR Computers program: Slate/tablets, two-in-ones, and portable all-in-ones. The proper categorization and definition of these new devices is still being determined at this time."

ENERGY STAR for Computers Version 6.0

As a reminder, Version 6.0 of the ENERGY STAR specification for Computers takes effect today (June 2, 2014). You can find this new specification [at this page](#).

By the end of today, all computers in the EPEAT Registry must be qualified to or comply with the eligibility criteria of ENERGY STAR for Computers Version 6.0. We ask that you check your product declarations for computer products and ensure that they are accurate.

Imaging Equipment Verification Round IE-2014-02 Now Underway

Imaging Equipment Verification Round IE-2014-02 is now underway. This round consists of two phases: the recently

completed Level 2 investigations and the upcoming Level 1 investigations.

The Level 2 investigations required no Subscriber participation and have already been completed. In those investigations the Qualified Verifiers reviewed publicly available information to assess conformance. The PVC recommendations for these Level 2 investigations were broken up into three categories:

1. **Conformance** - no Subscriber action is required
2. **Non-Conformance** - the Subscriber will move into an immediate Corrective Action Phase
3. **Inconclusive** - the Level 2 investigation will now move to a Level 1 investigation.

Investigation Reports have been created for all Level 2 investigations.
