Verification Round Plan for PC-2014-02

The Plan for Verification Round PC-2014-04 is now available and [can be found here](#). This Round will focus on packaging and will address two optional criteria: 4.8.4.1 (provision of take-back program for packaging) and 4.8.5.1 (documentation of reusable packaging). Twenty-five (25) investigations are planned.

A "snapshot" of the Registry showing manufacturer declarations at that point in time has been used to select products for investigation. Only products declaring criterion

4.8.4.1 or 4.8.5.1 were selected. Participating Manufacturers whose products were chosen were notified on November 14, 2014.

Outcomes Report: Verification Round IE-2014-02

Verification Round IE-2014-02 ended earlier in November. The Outcomes Report for this Round [can be found here](#) and provides detailed results.

This round entailed 40 "Level 0" and "Level 1" investigations. The Level 0 investigations involved the Qualified Verifier attempting to establish conformance based on publicly available information, as applicable. Several investigations were focused on declarations of "Not Applicable" in EPEAT and whether those declarations met the requirements.
